“ THE RESOLUTE ABANDONMENT OF ABSOLUTE  
SPACE TIME ”

Mr Bennett and his co-workers have developed a theory of universal correctedness to replace the classical notion of space-time as a receptacle independent of events. This theory was first published in *The Proceedings of the Royal Society*, “ Unified Field Theory in a Curvature-Free Five Dimensional Manifold ”.
